east half of the west half of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter and the Lot fifteen of Section three in Township one north of Range two east of the Wind River Meridian, Wyoming, containing twenty and forty-three hundredths acres;

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land above described for the period of twenty-five years in trust for the sole use and benefit of the said Indian, Herman Lajeunesse, subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions, as declared in the original trust patent covering the said land, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

This patent shall not operate to extend the trust period declared in the patent for said land dated May 6, 1907.
